Greenfield Village

Historic Baseball & World Tournament, Every Saturday and Sunday from June 12 through August 22, 2010, & August 14-15, 2010 (Open Saturday 'til 9pm)

Every summer weekend our historic baseball teams, the Lad-De-Dahs and the Nationals suit up to compete with outside historic clubs from around the Midwest. Stretch out on a grassy hillside and enjoy the game, played by 1867 rules.

Maker Faire July 31 & August 1, 2010

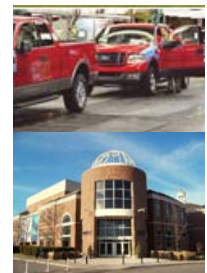
